Cool yellow-cadmium light or lemon	Ultramarine blue	Palette knives
Warm yellow- cadmium Medium	Green-Viridian	Canvas panels or stretched canvas
Cool red- permanent alizarin crimson	Yellow ochre	Paper for preliminary sketches
Warm red- cadmium red	Burnt sienna	Palette to mix paint onto
Cobalt blue	Titanium white	The Southside Art League has plenty of floor and table easels.
	Odorless mineral spirits	Empty pizza boxes make great boxes to transport wet paintings.

	Brushes- size 4-10 flats. (Suggested)	

Suggested pastel Supply List:

Small foam brush, old oil painting brushes

Isopropyl alcohol

Paper towels and gloves if you wish, hand wipes

Scrap paper for sketches

Drawing Board

Masking tape

Tracing paper to protect work for storing

Vine charcoal sticks (not compressed charcoal sticks)

Hard pastels - (nu pastels)

Soft pastels such as Sennelier, Schmincke, Unison, Terry Ludwig or any other soft pastels (Rembrandt pastels are labeled

“soft”, but are in- between hard and soft)

Suggestion: Get with a friend, buy a box of pastels and break each piece in half and share the expense. The more expensive the pastels are the more pigment they have and less filler.

Any sanded pastel papers

I will have sanded pastel paper for \$10.00 each. You can cut it into smaller sizes.
