### Bob Hunt



Bob Hunt is a lifelong resident of central Indiana. He enjoys both studio and plein air subjects for his creative work. Frequent subjects are the people, places, and scenes of everyday life. During the time of the pandemic, he created a significant series of scenes capturing the impact of social distancing, and all of the ways the community responded with resilience to a challenging and uncertain time.

Bob participates in local and regional exhibitions and has regularly won awards for his oil paintings. His work frequently includes a subtle narrative for the viewer to discover and interpret. One of his paintings

was chosen for inclusion in "Historic Indiana en Plein Air" published 2020 and also published in Plein Air Magazine. His paintings have been exhibited at the Indiana State Fair, Will Vawter Annual Art Exhibition, Cumberland Arts Exhibition, Irvington Artists Exhibition, Friends of TC Steele Annual Member Show, IPAPA Plein Air events and the Richmond Art Museum Annual Exhibition.

Beyond his own artwork, Bob has actively helped organize and promote the arts in central Indiana. In 2000 and 2001 he and wife Beverly created and curated the groundbreaking "Artistry in Wood" exhibition in Indianapolis, drawing fine woodworking artists from seventeen states. In 2008 they opened the "Creative Arts and Event Center" in downtown Greenfield Indiana. The Art Center included artist studios, and gallery spaces that hosted exhibitions and events over several years including the Annual Will Vawter Art Exhibition, Hoosier Salon Traveling Exhibit, numerous Hancock County Arts Exhibitions, and many other individual and group shows.

Now retired from the Art Center, Bob focuses on individual work. He is a member and past president of Hancock County Arts. He is also a member of IPAPA, Hoosier Salon, and Friends of TC Steele.

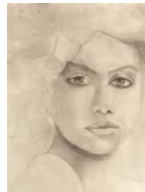

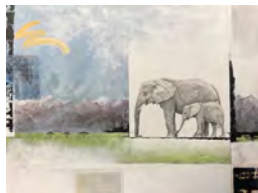

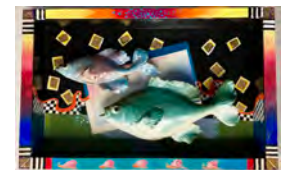
