EVENT: The Second Annual Student Art Show by the students of Amy Barile will be displayed at the Southside Art League Off Broadway Gallery in July 2026. Our Guest Artists will be celebrating a year of growth, creativity and hard work through approximately 40 pieces created at Teal Canary.

ARTISTS: The artists, ranging in age from 5 to 68, will be showing artwork in a wide variety of media, including watercolor, watercolor and ink, acrylic, pencil, reverse white-on-black drawings, and decoupage. The art exhibition highlights the artistic journeys of students of all ages and celebrates the belief that creativity can be explored, developed, and shared throughout a lifetime.

Amy Barile has been creating art since she was six years old. She earned her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Indiana State University in 1997. She opened Teal Canary in 2013, located on Madison Ave. in the heart of Old Town Greenwood. Through classes, individualized instruction, murals, and community art projects, she has spent more than three decades helping artists of all ages develop their creative voice. Teal Canary was founded on the belief that people of all ages benefit from making purposeful time to create art. She has created numerous murals throughout Johnson County.
