

Beginner Watercolor Class

With Annette Pokorny

Wednesday 6-8 pm

Three 2-hour class; \$40

(\$15 additional fee for paint, brushes, paper & palette)

You can bring your own materials or borrow them from the instructor for a fee.

Learn watercolor techniques and how to apply them to a painting.

Techniques include: Wet on wet, wet on dry, washes, brushwork, glazing, lifting and color theory mixing. Each session we will cover techniques used to complete a painting. Feel free to bring your own photos or ideas to class.

Suggested material; if you want to buy your own

Tube paints only

Do not need to purchase expensive paint. We will not be using pan palette style paint (tube paint only). *{Brands range from Cheap > expensive: Artist Loft (Michaels), \$Van Gogh, \$\$Winsor Newton or \$\$\$Daniel Smith}*. Suggested colors for a basic painting class: Ultramarine Blue, Cad Yellow, Cad Red, Hookers Green, Burnt Sienna and Burnt Umber.

Brushes

Natural blend (sable/natural hair) round brushes; sizes 4, 6; one 1/2" flat brush for washes. {The long handled brushes are used for oil or acrylic painting.}

Palette

Ceramic or plastic palette. Should have areas for mixing colors and enough spaces for all of your colors. Make sure it has deep wells for paint. Some have lids, others are open. A plastic or ceramic plate works as well for mixing areas.

Paper

140 lb. cold press or 300 grams watercolor paper in a tablet (9 x 12). Again, does not need to be expensive brands.

#2B Pencil, Kneaded Eraser, Blue Painters Tape & a Clipboard

Additional supplies may be mentioned in class but are not required; only if you wish to add your personal collection for painting.

In order to prep for classes, pre-registration is required. (812) 276-9849

Classes run for three consecutive weeks, not every week of the month.

Hello my name is Annette Pokorny, I am a former Art teacher from southern Indiana. I grew up in Nebraska and graduated from Peru State College with a B.S. of Fine Arts, in Peru, Nebraska. I have taught elementary through high school art in the classroom and have found the most joy in doing private classes and lessons. In 2005 I began teaching in Bloomington, IN at the catholic school summer program. For eight years I taught a variety of art classes to all age levels. From 2015 to 2018 I had my own studio "The Artist Palette" in Bedford, IN. This is where I worked with home schooled students, did paint parties and hosted a Summer Art Camp for three years. After my last daughter went to college, my husband and I decided to move closer to our kids. In 2019 we built a home in Whiteland, IN.

I have enjoyed getting to know everyone at SALI and always look forward to teaching classes. I will cover different applications for backgrounds and techniques used in basic watercolor painting. Classes will start on Wednesday evenings from 6 - 8 pm.

Fees start at \$40 for three 2-hour classes. Materials can be borrowed from me for a \$15 fee, or you can check the supply list for the class and purchase your own.

Classes are three consecutive weeks and are not on every week during the month. Reserving a place in class is required in order to prep for classes.
